## **Inserting Batteries**



Forcing the cover open can cause damage. Please follow the procedure below to open the cover.



Slide the bottom cover halfway.



\* The cover locks in this position.

Unlock the cover by sliding the lock down in the direction of the arrow.



\* Release fingers from lock and it springs back to the locked position.

With the cover unlocked, slide the cover some more.



\* The cover slides only to the position in the photograph.

Lift the cover to open it.



Insert the batteries.



\* Be sure the positive and negative terminals are oriented correctly.

Close the cover.
